

## **GLOBAL ENVIRONMENT FACILITY (GEF)**

### **Youth Conservation and Environmental Stewardship**

#### **Project purpose:**

- Encourage community participation, ownership, restore village pride.
- Provide a natural habitat for birds, insects, soil etc
- Provide a safe, convenient environmental learning site for youth/community/children
- Enhance community team work

#### **The Project Outline:**

##### **Phase One**

- Consultation meetings- set up a village environment advisory committee to discuss and raise awareness on the Park Conservation areas. (Committee made up of equal male to female ratio (eg 15 males, 15 females). Members aged between 16-60 (range of ages)  
After consultations the committee will assign tasks to individuals in regards to building the park and conservation area
- Primary schools and high school students from the area will be involved in activities throughout the whole project to learn about conservation and managing a project.
- TYC and the committee will develop brochures, log books (to map, take inventory of plants and animals in the area) and will update the weekly radio program.

##### **Phase Two**

- Trainings- to teach communities about park management, work plans, delegating, designing a maintenance plan.
- Set up park land- putting up signs and tracks, mapping area, place waste bins in area, tree planting (rare/traditional/medicinal plant species),
- Training on documenting and protecting park area.
